

## PräFalz

Preparing device with rotary cutter

The **PräFalz** is designed to prepare magazines, periodicals etc. prior to fan-binding and enables accurate attachment of a **PräPlast** paper strip to the (mostly cardboard) cover sheet which is to be bound. During the fan-binding process the **PräPlast** paper strip is glued and serves as a hinge for the cover sheet.

The **PräFalz** is equipped with a rotary cutter with scale on the right-hand side to cut the cover sheet to its trimmed size up to a maximum length of 34 cm. A cutting and dispensing mechanism for **PräPlast** strips is fitted to the upper side of the device. These strips are led accurately underneath a transparent bar to facitilicate the positioning of the cover sheet. The maximum strip length is 29.2 mm.

## The principle of operation

The cover sheet is cut to its trimmed size by means of the rotary cutter. It is then placed along the side stop on the right-hand side to position the **PräPlast** strip. For this purpose, remove the protective cover on the glue line by pulling it towards the right and across the deflecting roller. Like this, the **PräPlast** strip is pushed under the transparent bar into its correct position.

The cover sheet is now pushed against the upper stop and the **PräPlast** strip is cut off. It is then pressed onto the open glue line of the **PräPlast** strip.

The cover sheet is now equipped with the extra paper strip and ready to be fan-bound.

## **Accessories:**

**PräPlast** - Paper or cloth strips in rolls of 50 mtr x 18 mm. Equipped with a self-adhesive glue coating of 6 mm width on one side to attach the cover sheet
